## **Acts 10:6**

"God never used angels to show men the way of salvation; he used human agents to teach sinners the gospel they needed to hear. In the conversion of Cornelius and in the conversion of the Ethiopian eunuch, an angel was involved; but in each case the angel's involvement was limited to getting the sinner into contact with the preacher. Even when the Lord himself appeared to Saul, he did not tell Saul what to do to be saved. Rather, he brought Saul into contact with the human agent who instructed Saul."
