I Thessalonians : Introduction

- Time of Writing: Early 50s AD
- Written from Corinth
 - Paul was there about a year and 6 months
- Delivered by Timothy
- One of the first epistles written by Paul

I Thessalonians : Introduction

- Major divisions of the book:
 - 1:1-3:13 : Paul's gratitude, concern, and relief concerning the Thessalonians
 - 4:1-5:28 : Instructions concerning their behavior and topics of concern, and concluding remarks

I Thessalonians : Introduction

- Alternative Outline (4 I's in the 7 C's):
 - 1:1-10 : Conversion: of the Thessalonians and Paul's thanksgiving concerning it
 - 2:1-16 : Coming: of Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy to them was not in vain

I Thessalonians : Introduction

- Alternative Outline (4 I's in the 7 C's):
 - 2:17-3:13 :
 - Conflict: persecution of (Paul and) the Thessalonians
 - Concern: that they might break under the pressure
 - Comfort: via Timothy's report that the brethren were faithful

 - 4:1-5:28 : Conduct and Conclusion:
 - 4:1-12 : Instruction concerning holiness
 - 4:13-18 : Instruction concerning the dead in Christ

 - 5:12-28 : Instruction concerning various topics and conclusion

- Instruction x4: holiness, dead in Christ, day of the Lord, various topics

I Thessalonians 4

- **Question #1:** What command does Paul give in verse 1? How were they to abound more and more?
- **Question #2:** How were they to be different than the Gentiles around them?

I Thessalonians 4

- **Question #3:** To what had God called them (verse 7)?
- **Question #4:** What were the Thessalonians taught by God to do?

I Thessalonians 4

- **Question #5:** To what were they to aspire?
- **Question #6:** What issue did Paul address starting in verse 13? What was his explanation?

I Thessalonians 4

- **Question #7:** What were they to do concerning “these words”?

I Thessalonians 5

- **Question #1:** What had Paul discussed with the Thessalonians before starting in verse 1? What related topic does he begin to discuss now?
- **Question #2:** How were they sons of light or sons of the day?

- **Question #3:** What two things did Paul tell them to do “in light of” what they knew (verse 6)?
- **Question #4:** What were they to do for each other (verse 11)?

- **Question #5:** What were they to do concerning certain individuals (verses 12-14)?
- **Question #6:** How might one quench the Spirit?
