JEREMIAH 1:1-10

GOD HAS A PURPOSE FOR YOU

- The language here is very personal (1:5).
- God is no less familiar with you than He is with Jeremiah (Lk. 12:6-7).
- Your words to Him are specifically cared for (1 Pet. 5:7).
- His words to you (though delivered generally) are no less special (1 Pet. 1:10-12; 2 Pet. 1:3).

SPEAK HIS WORDS

- It is entirely reasonable to feel inadequate to speak on behalf of God (1:6-7).
- We need to place our confidence in His words and the power that comes with proclaiming them (Rom. 1:16).
- We need to make those words ours to the point that we must speak them (Jer. 20:8-9).
- How much time do you spend learning other things in your life?

HE IS WITH YOU

- It should be a great comfort to hear that God is with us (1:8).
- Consider how the rest of Jeremiah's life plays out.
- We will be discouraged if we think God guarantees obvious victory.
- Promises like this are meant to give boldness that the spokesmen of God must always have (Rom. 8:31).
