NKJV footnote on Numbers 3:28

The total is a rounded off number; it does not duplicate the precise total of 22,300. Some modern scholars try to explain it by positing an error in v. 28, suggesting that "six" should be read as "three" (ช่ชู [shesh] as שֵׁלשׁ [shalosh]).

**NET translation note on Numbers 3:39** 

We must rather assume that there is a copyist's error in the number of one of the Levitical families; possibly in Numbers 3:28 we should read שׁלשׁ for 8300) www for 8600). [sic]


