

# I Want Them to Remember the Principles of Modesty

- God Expects His People to Dress In A Modest Way
  - 1 Timothy 2:8-10

I desire therefore that the men pray everywhere, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting; in like manner also, the women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with propriety and moderation, not with braided hair or gold or pearls or costly clothing, but, which is proper for women professing godliness, with good works

W. E. Vine: "orderly, well-arranged, decent, ...
The well-ordering is not of dress and demeanor only, but of the inner life, uttering indeed and expressing itself in the outward conversation."

(Vol. III, p. 79).

Bauer: "respectable, honorable" (p. 445).

Kubo: "modest, respectable" (p. 205).

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"A sense of shame, modesty, is used regarding the demeanor of women in the church, I Tim. 2:9 ... 'Shamefastness is that modesty which is 'fast' or rooted in the character...' (Davies; Bible English, p. 12).... 'Aidos would always restrain a good man from and unworthy act,...' (Trench, Syn §§ xix, xx)" (Vines, Vol. IV, p. 17)

Strong suggests that it may be from two words which would give the idea of "downcast eyes" thus meaning "bashfulness" (#127).

"Soundness of mind... 'sound judgment' practically expresses the meaning; 'it is that habitual inner self- government, with its constant rein on all the passions and desires which would hinder the temptation to these from arising...." (Vines, Vol. IV, pp. 44-45). "Soundness of mind, i.e.(lit,) sanity or (fig.) self-control" (Strongs, #4997).


