## MICAH'S MESSAGE

- He is prophesying during the same time as Isaiah (1:1).
- His message is one of sure judgment against Israel and severe warning against Judah (1:2-4).
- The prophets spoke what they were paid to speak (3:5).
- In the midst of all of this judgment, there is Messianic hope (4:1).
- For the next two chapters, God makes His case against His people before all of creation (6:1).

## THE RESPONSES

- Don't say that, we're fine! (2:6-7; Matt. 3:9; Jn. 9:34; Rom. 9-11; Matt. 24:37-39)
- What am I supposed to do about it? (6:6-8; Lk. 10:26; Matt. 25:24-27).
- They think they're better than us! (7:5-6; Matt. 10:34-36; Lk. 8:19-21; 14:26).
- I trust in the Lord (7:8-9; Matt. 15:26-28; Lk. 7:37-50; Heb. 4:15-16).
