**Lesson 5:** Faith that Pleases

- To Hebrew Christians fatigued by persecution
- Jesus: Final Messenger
- Jesus: Greater than the prophets
- Jesus: Greater than the angels

- Exhortation & warning
  - Heed His words, or drift away
  - Worse punishment for unfaithful than OT
- Jesus: Made a little lower than angels
  - High priest, captain of our salvation
  - Flesh & blood; temptation, suffering, & death

- Jesus: Greater than Moses
  - Apostle & high priest
  - The Son greater than the servant
- Beware unbelief
  - The fathers fell short of God's rest
  - Rest still awaits the faithful

- Jesus: Greater than Aaron/Levi
  - Without sin
  - Appointed by God
- Rebuke and encouragement
  - Admonition for spiritual immaturity
  - "Confident of better things concerning you"

- God assured Abram (and us) with an oath
- Jesus: Order of Melchizedek
  - Greater than Abraham, Levi
  - Priesthood by oath of God, not law/lineage
  - Always lives
- Jesus: Better sacrifice than bulls & goats

- Jesus: Better covenant/testament
  - Our God, His people
  - God's laws in minds & hearts
  - All know God
  - Full, eternal atonement

# HOLD FAST WITHOUT WAVERING

ENTER THE HOLIEST BY THE BLOOD OF JESUS

- Press forward, do not draw back (10:19–39)
  - Enter the Holiest with boldness (10:19; cf. 9:8)
  - Draw near with a true heart (10:22)
  - Hold fast the confession of hope (10:23)
  - See the day approaching (10:24, 25)
  - Warning for those who draw back (10:37, 38)

- Argumentation section concluded
- Metaphor for faith (11:1)
  - What it does for those who possess it
  - ♦ Not blind: Prior evidence → trust in promises
    - Faith comes by ... (Rom 10:17)
      - Hearing, Word of God
      - Not dreams, wishes, desires, traditions, etc.
      - Not just any promise, but those in God's word

- What must we believe to please God? (11:6)
  - 1. God **is**, and
  - 2. He rewards those who diligently seek Him
  - ❖ God is great: We stand in awe (Ps 33:8, 9)
  - God is good: We love Him (Jas 1:17, 18; 1Jn 4:19)

- ❖ What kinds of words follow "by faith ..."?
  - Abel offered (11:4)
  - Noah prepared (11:7)
  - Abraham obeyed (11:8)
  - Moses refused, chose, endured (11:24, 26, 27)
  - ❖ Faith → Action

- What is the "good testimony" in 11:2?
  - Not the story of one's own spiritual journey
  - A timeless honor by God Almighty (11:16)

- What does Abel's blood still say? (11:4)
  - Offer the worship God has asked for (Gen 4:3-5)
  - God accepts the new, rejects the old
  - Careful what you offer as worship

- How did Noah demonstrate his faith? (11:7)
  - Prepared an ark (Gen 6)
  - Prepared for the as-yet unseen (11:7)
  - The unseen greater that the visible (11:3)
  - Look to the unseen, not the visible

- Why did Abraham live in a foreign land? (11:8–16)
  - Waited for a city built by God (11:10)
  - Died without receiving the promises (11:13)
  - "I am the God of ..." (11:16)
  - Depart your nation for the eternal
