Lessons 5 & 6: Faith that Pleases and Solemn Warnings

- To Hebrew Christians fatigued by persecution
- Jesus: Final Messenger
- Jesus: Greater than the prophets
- Jesus: Greater than the angels

- Exhortation & warning: Heed or drift away
- Jesus: Made a little lower than angels
  - High priest, captain of our salvation
  - Flesh & blood; temptation, suffering, & death
- Jesus: Greater than Moses

- Beware unbelief
  - The fathers fell short of God's rest
  - Rest still awaits the faithful
- Jesus: Better High Priest (order of Melchizedek)
  - Without sin
  - Author of eternal salvation

- Rebuke and encouragement
  - Admonition for spiritual immaturity
  - "Confident of better things concerning you"
- God assured Abram (and us) with an oath

- Jesus: Order of Melchizedek
  - Greater than Abraham, Levi
  - Priesthood by oath of God, not law/lineage
  - Always lives
- Jesus: Better sacrifice than bulls & goats

- Jesus: Better covenant/testament
  - Our God, His people
  - God's laws in minds & hearts
  - All know God
  - Full, eternal atonement
- Exhortation to press on, hold fast

- Faith
  - Substance of things hoped for
  - Evidence of things not seen
  - God exists and rewards the diligent
  - Several OT examples of faithfulness

- What did Moses choose? (11:24–26)
  - Affliction over pleasure (11:25)
  - Reproach over riches (11:26)
  - Leave comfort, endure suffering
  - Moses saw the Invisible
    - Kept the Passover, spared destruction
    - Passed through the Red Sea unharmed

- Why could Egypt not cross the Red Sea? (11:29)
  - Would they have attempted to cross unless they believed?
  - God made no promise to deliver them
  - Did not act in faith

- What caused the Jericho's walls to fall? (11:30)
  - The power of God
  - Circled for seven days: perseverance, diligence
  - Persevere first, then see the power of God

- Why did some refuse deliverance? (11:35)
  - To obtain a better resurrection
  - Like Moses, choosing affliction over pleasure
  - Refuse relief, receive a better resurrection (Rev 13:13)

- Why did these not receive the promise? (11:39, 40)
  - God provides us something better
  - God makes us perfect with them
- \* "Of whom the world was not worthy" (11:38)

## THE MORE EARNEST HEED

HOW SHALL WE ESCAPE?

- What would happen if they did not heed? (2:1)
  - Drift away Gradual, unintentional
- Consequence of failing to heed angels? (2:2-4)
  - Just reward: death
  - Lot's wife? The law? (Gal 3:19; Acts 7:53)
  - ❖ Lesser → greater: Angels < Jesus</p>

# DEPARTING FROM THE LIVING GOD

DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEARTS

- Hardened hearts: Contrasts with drifting (3:8)
- What caused their hearts to harden? (3:12, 13)
  - Evil heart of unbelief (cf. 3:19)
  - Deceitfulness of sin
- How to avoid drifting? (3:13)
  - Daily exhortation (10:24, 25; Php 2:4)

  - Came out of Egypt, led by Moses
  - Sinned
  - Disobeyed
  - Did not believe
