Purposes/Uses Of The Book

(Prov. 1:2-6)

• 2 To know wisdom and instruction, To perceive the words of understanding, 3 To receive the instruction of wisdom, Justice, judgment, and equity; 4 To give prudence to the simple, To the young man knowledge and discretion-- 5 A wise [man] will hear and increase learning, And a man of understanding will attain wise counsel, 6 To understand a proverb and an enigma, The words of the wise and their riddles.

What Is A Proverb?

- Proverb a ruling saying
 - General rule (not exception)
 - Provide godly wisdom (Prov. 1:7)
 - Meant to be applied on earth
 - Written for application! (Jas. 1:22-25)

Wisdom Review

- Get wisdom! (4:5,7)
- Blessings of wisdom:
 - Success! (24:3-7)
 - Perspective (17:24; 22:3)
 - More wisdom (14:6; 21:20)

- Instruction, warning, correction, discipline, chastisement
- [Pro 27:5-6 NKJV] 5 Open rebuke [is] better Than love carefully concealed. 6 Faithful [are] the wounds of a friend, But the kisses of an enemy [are] deceitful.

- [Pro 28:23 NKJV] 23 He who rebukes a man will find more favor afterward Than he who flatters with the tongue.
- NT Examples:
 - Peter (Luk. 22:31-32; Gal. 2:11-14)
 - Simon (Acts 8:18-24)
 - Apollos (Acts (18:24-26)

Receiving Instruction What Attitude?

- [Pro 23:23 NKJV] 23 Buy the truth, and do not sell [it], [Also] wisdom and instruction and understanding.
- [Pro 12:1 NKJV] 1 Whoever loves instruction loves knowledge, But he who hates correction [is] stupid.
- [Pro 13:13-14 NKJV] 13 He who despises the word will be destroyed, But he who fears the commandment will be rewarded. 14 The law of the wise [is] a fountain of life, To turn [one] away from the snares of death.
- [Pro 10:16-17 NKJV] 16 The labor of the righteous [leads] to life,
 The wages of the wicked to sin. 17 He who keeps instruction [is in] the way of life, But he who refuses correction goes astray.

Receiving Instruction What Source?

- [Pro 13:20 NKJV] 20 He who walks with wise [men] will be wise, But the companion of fools will be destroyed.
- [Pro 12:15 NKJV] 15 The way of a fool [is] right in his own eyes, But he who heeds counsel [is] wise.

Receiving Rebukes Effective Rebukes

- [Pro 25:11-12 NKJV] 11 A word fitly spoken [is like] apples of gold In settings of silver. 12 [Like] an earring of gold and an ornament of fine gold [Is] a wise rebuker to an obedient ear.
- [Pro 15:5 NKJV] 5 A fool despises his father's instruction, But he who receives correction is prudent.
- [Pro 20:30 NKJV] 30 Blows that hurt cleanse away evil, As [do] stripes the inner depths of the heart.
- [Pro 17:10 NKJV] 10 Rebuke is more effective for a wise [man] Than a hundred blows on a fool.

Receiving Rebukes

Reactions

- [Pro 19:25 NKJV] 25 Strike a scoffer, and the simple will become wary; Rebuke one who has understanding, [and] he will discern knowledge.
- [Pro 21:11 NKJV] 11 When the scoffer is punished, the simple is made wise; But when the wise is instructed, he receives knowledge.

Receiving Rebukes Rejecting Rebukes

- [Pro 29:1 NKJV] 1 He who is often rebuked, [and] hardens [his] neck, Will suddenly be destroyed, and that without remedy.
- [Pro 15:10-12 NKJV] 10 Harsh discipline [is] for him who forsakes the way, [And] he who hates correction will die. 11 Hell and Destruction [are] before the LORD; So how much more the hearts of the sons of men. 12 A scoffer does not love one who corrects him, Nor will he go to the wise.
