Responsibilities & Blessings Of Benevolence – God's View

- [Pro 17:4-5 NKJV] 4 An evildoer gives heed to false lips; A liar listens eagerly to a spiteful tongue. 5 He who mocks the poor reproaches his Maker; He who is glad at calamity will not go unpunished.
- [Pro 19:17 NKJV] 17 He who has pity on the poor lends to the LORD, And He will pay back what he has given.
- [Pro 29:7 NKJV] 7 The righteous considers the cause of the poor, [But] the wicked does not understand [such] knowledge.
- [Pro 19:22 NKJV] 22 What is desired in a man is kindness, And a poor man is better than a liar.

Responsibilities & Blessings Of

Benevolence – Benefits To The Giver

- [Pro 11:17 NKJV] 17 The merciful man does good for his own soul, But [he who is] cruel troubles his own flesh.
- [Pro 22:9 NKJV] 9 He who has a generous eye will be blessed, For he gives of his bread to the poor.
- [Pro 28:27 NKJV] 27 He who gives to the poor will not lack, But he who hides his eyes will have many curses.
- [Pro 21:13 NKJV] 13 Whoever shuts his ears to the cry of the poor Will also cry himself and not be heard.

Laziness Leads To Poverty – Warnings Against Laziness

- [Pro 16:26 NKJV] 26 The person who labors, labors for himself, For his [hungry] mouth drives him [on].
- [Pro 12:14 NKJV] 14 A man will be satisfied with good by the fruit of [his] mouth, And the recompense of a man's hands will be rendered to him.

Laziness Leads To Poverty – Warnings Against Laziness

- [Pro 10:4 NKJV] 4 He who has a slack hand becomes poor, But the hand of the diligent makes rich.
- [Pro 19:15 NKJV] 15 Laziness casts [one] into a deep sleep, And an idle person will suffer hunger.
- [Pro 14:23 NKJV] 23 In all labor there is profit, But idle chatter [leads] only to poverty.

Laziness Leads To Poverty – What The Lazy Man *Does*

- [Pro 13:4 NKJV] 4 The soul of a lazy [man] desires, and [has] nothing; But the soul of the diligent shall be made rich.
- [Pro 21:25-26 NKJV] 25 The desire of the lazy [man] kills him, For his hands refuse to labor. 26 He covets greedily all day long, But the righteous gives and does not spare.
- [Pro 20:13 NKJV] 13 Do not love sleep, lest you come to poverty; Open your eyes, [and] you will be satisfied with bread.
- [Pro 26:14-15 NKJV] 14 [As] a door turns on its hinges, So [does] the lazy [man] on his bed. 15 The lazy [man] buries his hand in the bowl; It wearies him to bring it back to his mouth.

Laziness Leads To Poverty – What The Lazy Man *Doesn't*

- [Pro 24:27 NKJV] 27 Prepare your outside work, Make it fit for yourself in the field; And afterward build your house.
- [Pro 12:27 NKJV] 27 The lazy [man] does not roast what he took in hunting, But diligence [is] man's precious possession.

Laziness Leads To Poverty – What The Lazy Man *Doesn't*

• [Pro 24:30-34 NKJV] 30 I went by the field of the lazy [man], And by the vineyard of the man devoid of understanding; 31 And there it was, all overgrown with thorns; Its surface was covered with nettles; Its stone wall was broken down. 32 When I saw [it], I considered [it] well; I looked on [it and] received instruction: 33 A little sleep, a little slumber, A little folding of the hands to rest; 34 So shall your poverty come [like] a prowler, And your need like an armed man.

Laziness Leads To Poverty – The Lazy Man Always Has An Excuse

- [Pro 26:16 NKJV] 16 The lazy [man is] wiser in his own eyes Than seven men who can answer sensibly.
- [Pro 15:19 NKJV] 19 The way of the lazy [man is] like a hedge of thorns, But the way of the upright [is] a highway.
- [Pro 20:4 NKJV] 4 The lazy [man] will not plow because of winter; He will beg during harvest and [have] nothing.
- [Pro 22:13 NKJV] 13 The lazy [man] says, "[There is] a lion outside! I shall be slain in the streets!"

Laziness Leads To Poverty – The Lazy Man Is A Burden

- [Pro 18:9 NKJV] 9 He who is slothful in his work Is a brother to him who is a great destroyer.
- [Pro 10:26 NKJV] 26 As vinegar to the teeth and smoke to the eyes, So [is] the lazy [man] to those who send him.
- [Pro 26:14 NKJV] 14 [As] a door turns on its hinges, So [does] the lazy [man] on his bed.

Poor Choices In Borrowing & Lending

- [Pro 22:7 NKJV] 7 The rich rules over the poor, And the borrower [is] servant to the lender.
- [Pro 17:18 NKJV] 18 A man devoid of understanding shakes hands in a pledge, [And] becomes surety for his friend.
- [Pro 22:26-27 NKJV] 26 Do not be one of those who shakes hands in a pledge, One of those who is surety for debts; 27 If you have nothing [with which] to pay, Why should he take away your bed from under you?

- **Poor Choices In Borrowing & Lending**
- [Pro 27:13 NKJV] 13 Take the garment of him who is surety for a stranger, And hold it in pledge [when] he is surety for a seductress.

Wickedness Leads To Poverty

- [Pro 11:24 NKJV] 24 There is [one] who scatters, yet increases more; And there is [one] who withholds more than is right, But it [leads] to poverty.
- [Pro 22:16 NKJV] 16 He who oppresses the poor to increase his [riches], [And] he who gives to the rich, [will] surely [come] to poverty.
- [Pro 13:25 NKJV] 25 The righteous eats to the satisfying of his soul, But the stomach of the wicked shall be in want.

Paths To Poverty – Foolishness Leads To Poverty

- [Pro 28:19 NKJV] 19 He who tills his land will have plenty of bread, But he who follows frivolity will have poverty enough!
- [Pro 21:17 NKJV] 17 He who loves pleasure [will be] a poor man; He who loves wine and oil will not be rich.

Foolishness Leads To Poverty

• [Pro 27:23-27 NKJV] 23 Be diligent to know the state of your flocks, [And] attend to your herds; 24 For riches [are] not forever, Nor does a crown [endure] to all generations. 25 [When] the hay is removed, and the tender grass shows itself, And the herbs of the mountains are gathered in, 26 The lambs [will provide] your clothing, And the goats the price of a field; 27 [You shall have] enough goats' milk for your food, For the food of your household, And the nourishment of your maidservants.
