Controlling The Tongue: Gossip & Flattery – Gossip Damages Relationships

- [Pro 17:9 NKJV] 9 He who covers a transgression seeks love, But he who repeats a matter separates friends.
- [Pro 11:13 NKJV] 13 A talebearer reveals secrets, But he who is of a faithful spirit conceals a matter.

Controlling The Tongue: Gossip & Flattery – Talebearers & Tale-receivers

- [Pro 26:20 NKJV] 20 Where [there is] no wood, the fire goes out; And where [there is] no talebearer, strife ceases.
- [Pro 26:22 NKJV] 22 The words of a talebearer [are] like tasty trifles, And they go down into the inmost body.

Controlling The Tongue: Gossip & Flattery – Predictable Results Of Gossip

 [Pro 25:23 NKJV] 23 The north wind brings forth rain, And a backbiting tongue an angry countenance.

Controlling The Tongue: Gossip & Flattery – Flattery Is Deceitful

- [Pro 26:25 NKJV] 25 When he speaks kindly, do not believe him, For [there are] seven abominations in his heart;
- [Pro 29:5 NKJV] 5 A man who flatters his neighbor Spreads a net for his feet.
- [Pro 20:19 NKJV] 19 He who goes about [as] a talebearer reveals secrets; Therefore do not associate with one who flatters with his lips.

Controlling The Tongue: Gossip & Flattery – Rebuke Or Flattery?

 [Pro 28:23 NKJV] 23 He who rebukes a man will find more favor afterward Than he who flatters with the tongue.

OATHS, CURSING, BOASTING & HASTY SPEECH

- [Pro 20:25 NKJV] 25 [It is] a snare for a man to devote rashly [something as] holy, And afterward to reconsider [his] vows.
- [Pro 25:14 NKJV] 14 Whoever falsely boasts of giving [Is like] clouds and wind without rain.

- [Pro 20:20 NKJV] 20 Whoever curses his father or his mother, His lamp will be put out in deep darkness.
- [Pro 30:11 NKJV] 11 [There is] a generation [that] curses its father, And does not bless its mother.
- [Pro 26:2 NKJV] 2 Like a flitting sparrow, like a flying swallow, So a curse without cause shall not alight.

- [Pro 27:1 NKJV] 1 Do not boast about tomorrow, For you do not know what a day may bring forth.

- [Pro 11:9 NKJV] 9 The hypocrite with [his] mouth destroys his neighbor, But through knowledge the righteous will be delivered.
- [Pro 12:6 NKJV] 6 The words of the wicked [are], "Lie in wait for blood," But the mouth of the upright will deliver them.

- [Pro 15:28 NKJV] 28 The heart of the righteous studies how to answer, But the mouth of the wicked pours forth evil.
- [Pro 12:18 NKJV] 18 There is one who speaks like the piercings of a sword, But the tongue of the wise [promotes] health.
- [Pro 14:9 NKJV] 9 Fools mock at sin, But among the upright [there is] favor.
