Consequences Of Strife

- [Pro 26:17 NKJV] 17 He who passes by [and] **meddles in a quarrel not his own** [Is like] one who takes a dog by the ears.
- [Pro 17:1 NKJV] 1 Better [is] a dry morsel with quietness, Than a house full of feasting [with] strife.
- [Pro 18:18-19 NKJV] 18 Casting lots causes contentions to cease, And keeps the mighty apart. 19 A brother offended [is harder to win] than a strong city, And contentions [are] like the bars of a castle.
- [Pro 17:19 NKJV] 19 He who **loves transgression loves strife**, And he who exalts his gate seeks destruction.

Joy Of Wise Children

- [Pro 17:6 NKJV] 6 Children's children [are] the crown of old men, And the glory of children [is] their father.
- [Pro 29:17 NKJV] 17 Correct your son, and he will give you rest; Yes, he will give delight to your soul.

Purpose & Benefits Of Discipline
