SUBSTANCE AND EVIDENCE

- This is a continuation of the discussion in the previous chapter (Heb. 10:34-39).
- Faith is evidence (Heb. 11:3; Rom. 1:19-20).
- Faith is substance (Heb. 1:3; Lk. 2:25-32; Psa. 34:8).
- This sort of faith is necessary (Heb. 11:6).
