



# STRANGE FIRE

Leviticus 10:1-11

# BEFORE THE SIN

- They had been in the very presence of God to eat and drink (Ex. 24:9-11).
- They experienced God's grace after great national sin (Ex. 32-34).
- They went through a solemn ceremony dedicating themselves to God's service (Lev. 8:23-24).
- They watched fire come from God and consume the sacrifices (Lev. 9:24).





# THEIR FAILURE

- They did not treat God as holy nor did they honor Him (v. 3).
- Their irreverence was likely bolstered by alcohol (v. 9).
- They mixed the holy with the profane (v. 10).
- There is mercy for Aaron's other sons later in the chapter (v. 16-20).



# GOD IS RIGHT

- It seems as though Aaron is ready to comment before Moses steps in (v. 3).
- God does not delight in casting down godly men at the first chance (2 Sam. 6:6-7).
- No one asks why God spares people in their sins.
- We should never call on God to be more “fair” (v. 3-7).
