### The Devestation

- 2 Kings 25
- Psalm 74:3-9; Psalm 79:1-4
  - Jerusalem and the temple defiled and destroyed
  - No prophet remained to inquire of God
- Psalm 80:1-2, 5-6, 12-13, 16
  - Not only Judah, but Samaria and Israel as well
  - Pilfered by all who pass
- Psalm 89:38-45
  - Upbeat in 1-37 remembering the covenant promises
  - Book ends with no king on the throne (v. 39, 44)

#### The Laments

- Psalm 73:1-14 (Personal)
  - "If I didn't know better..." (v. 1-2)
  - What he sees and hears (v. 3-12)
  - "Am I wasting my time?" (v. 13-14)
- Psalm 88 (Corporate)
  - Incline/Bow down and hear (v. 2; 86:1)
  - Darkness throughout
  - No resolution of hope

### How Long? Why?

- "Why do you withdraw Your hand?" (74:1, 10-11)
- "Has God forgotten to be gracious?" (77:7-10)
- "Will you be angry forever?" (79:5-10)
- "Restore us... that Your people may rejoice in You." (85:5-7)
- "Where are Your former lovingkindnesses... which You swore to David?" (89:46-49)
