- <u>Ascension of Jesus / Appointment of Matthias</u>
 Jesus ascends to heaven
 God appoints Matthias to replace Judas
- <u>Birth of the church</u>
 The Holy Spirit comes on Pentecost
 Peter preaches the first gospel sermon
 The Lord begins to build His church





- 3 <u>Cripple cured</u> Peter heals a lame man at the temple Peter preaches to the people at Solomon's Porch
- 4 <u>Disciples detained</u>

Peter and John stand before the Sanhedrin Prayer for boldness The church provides for its needy





- <u>Executed liars</u>
 Ananias and Sapphira
 The apostles imprisoned, freed, arrested again, and brought before the Sanhedrin
- <u>Faithful Stephen chosen</u>
 Seven chosen for service
 Stephen preaches boldly and is charged with blasphemy





- 7 <u>Great sermon by Stephen</u> Stephen's sermon and stoning
- 8 <u>Here is water</u>
 - The church is persecuted and scatters Simon the sorcerer
 - The Ethiopian eunuch





- 9 Into Damascus
 The conversion of Saul of Tarsus
 Peter heals Aeneas and raises Dorcas
 - 10 Joy brought to Cornelius
 The first Gentile converts: Cornelius, his relatives & friends





- 11 <u>Kingdom given to the Gentiles</u>
 Peter defends sharing the gospel with Gentiles
 The church in Antioch and famine in Judea
- Loosed leader Peter / Learn from the worms
 Herod executes James the son of Zebedee
 Herod imprisons Peter; an angel frees him
 God strikes Herod with a fatal case of worms





13 <u>Missionaries march</u>

1st preaching journey begins: Cyprus and Antioch-Pisidia

14 <u>Not gods</u>, but men

1st preaching journey continues: Iconium, Lystra, Derbe 1st preaching journey concludes: Revisiting the churches and return to Antioch





- 15 <u>Old law no more / Objection to taking John Mark</u> Argument over circumcision and keeping the Law of Moses
- 16 Purple seller / Philippian jailer
 2nd preaching journey begins: Timothy joins at Lystra, into Macedonia, Philippi
 The conversions of Lydia and the Philippian jailer





17 Quest for knowledge

2nd preaching journey continues: Thessalonica, Berea, Athens

18 <u>Reteaching Apollos</u>

2nd preaching journey concludes: Corinth and return to Antioch

3rd preaching journey begins: Galatia and Phrygia Aquila and Priscilla correct Apollos





- 19 <u>Seven sons of Sceva</u> 3rd preaching journey cor
 - 3rd preaching journey continues: Ephesus
- <u>Three-story fall (Eutychus) /</u>
 <u>Take heed, elders of Ephesus</u>
 3rd preaching journey continues: Macedonia, Greece,
 Troas, Miletus
 - Paul's address to the elders of the church in Ephesus





21 <u>Uproar in Jerusalem</u>

3rd preaching journey concludes: Miletus to JerusalemPaul is seized in the temple and rescued by the Romangarrison

22 <u>Valuable citizenship</u> Paul's address to the mob Paul asserts his right as Roman





23 Waiting to kill Paul Paul addresses the Sanhedrin The conspiracy to kill Paul The Roman commander sends Paul to Felix in Caesarea
