The first Gentile converts: Cornelius, his relatives & friends

## 11 Kingdom given to the Gentiles

Peter defends sharing the gospel with Gentiles

The church in Antioch and famine in Judea

## 12 Loosed leader Peter / Learn from the worms

Herod executes James the son of Zebedee

Herod imprisons Peter; an angel frees him

God strikes Herod with a fatal case of worms
