

- 5. How do we know that Luke was referring to the Lord's Supper when he wrote, "on the first day of the week, when the disciples [in Troas] came together to break bread"?

6. What happened to Eutychus? What was Paul able to do for him?

7. **Thought Question** Why did Paul continue talking all the way to midnight? Did he really speak to them for over twelve hours?

- 8. In addition to Pentecost, what was apparently another reason that Paul wanted to head to Jerusalem? (1Co. 16:1–4; Rom. 15:25–31)
- 9. As he spoke to the Ephesian elders in Miletus, how did Paul characterize his service to the Lord, his teaching, and his labor while he was in Ephesus?

10. What was the Holy Spirit warning Paul about in every city as he journeyed?

11. What charges and warnings did Paul have for the elders from Ephesus?

12. When did Jesus say, "It is more blessed to give than to receive"?

13. How did Paul's meeting with the Ephesian elders conclude?
