### The Psalms of Orientation

- These psalms reflect the confident belief that the world is well ordered, reliable and life giving to the person of faith.
- Initial understanding of God and the world in which we live.
- This is a necessary step of faith, but we must not remain in this phase forever.

#### The Psalms of Disorientation

- These psalms reflect the brokenness of life when it is no longer orderly, but savage.
- They are spoken out of the depths, they are still bold acts of faith.
- We tend to be uncomfortable hearing of this state.
- God has no intention of leaving us here.

#### The Psalms of New Orientation

- The "pit" is not the end of life there is more!
- The "New Orientation" psalms reflect the surprise of new possibilities that are experienced as a gift of God.
- These powerful psalms are descriptive of the faith that has endured the trial and seen the glory of God!

### What Does the Book of Psalms Teach Us?

- Didactic (Instructive) Frame:
  - Worship to God should be an instructive experience.
- Dominance of the Lament.
- Doxological Direction:
  - Praise is not only for the high points, but also the low points.
  - Joy is a discipline!
