# WAIT

- The book starts out with the question of waiting (Hab. 1:2).
- Judgment is then described (Hab. 1:5-11).
- It is difficult to see the hand of God in a wicked world (Hab. 1:13).
- Nevertheless, wait faithfully (Hab. 2:3-4).

# BE SILENT

- God is not mocked, but Babylon is (Hab. 2:6-8).
- People will hear about what God is doing (Hab. 2:14).
- Idols do not speak, but God does (Hab. 2:19-20).



# REJOICE

- God is depicted as a grand cosmic general (Hab. 3:3-15).
- This leads to fear and trembling (Hab. 3:16).
- Which leads to joy and confidence for those who live by faith (Hab. 3:17-19).
