 - Fully realized in the gospel (Eph. 4:24; 2 Cor. 3:18; Col. 3:6ff; 1 Jn. 3:1-3)

6. God obviously had no physical need of rest on the seventh day. What then, was the purpose in doing so?


- Literally "to cease" or "desist"
- Day of rest and remembrance (Ex. 20:8-11)
- Sign of sanctification (Ex. 31:13ff; Ezek. 20:12)
- As a reminder of God's deliverance (Deut. 5:12-15)
- Call to holiness (Isa. 58:13-14)
- Shadow of the coming rest (Heb. 4:10-11)


7. In the description of the garden, what two trees are named specifically? While one will play a role in chapter three, where does the other appear again in scripture?

- Tree of life
- Tree of the knowledge of good and evil
- Rev. 2:7; 22:2, 14

- 8. What reason is given for the creation of woman? How does that harmonize with much of the world's opinion today?
 - "Not good"
 - Man was alone
 - A helper suitable was not found
 - World view: demeaning/devaluation God elevates in scripture
 - Created in God's image (1:27)
 - o Prov. 31:10ff "Worth far above jewels"
 - 1 Pet. 3:5 "Fellow heir of the grace of life"

 - A godly woman (1 Tim. 2:11ff)

- Rev. 12:9-12 Great dragon, serpent of old, devil, deceiver
