
LESSON 9 - GENESIS 27-31

- 6. What blessing did Isaac ask for Jacob when he sent him away?
 - God Almighty (El-Shaddai)
 - "Make you fruitful and multiply you, that you may become a company of peoples."
 - "The blessings of Abraham... to your descendants with you"
 - "That you may possess the land of your sojourning, which God gave to Abraham"



- 7. What are we told Esau did when he saw his father's blessing and his brother's obedience?
 - Realization of verse eight
 - Sought his father's approval by marrying "within" the family
 - Mahalath (Basemath in 36:3), daughter of Ishmael





- Transformation begins
- Jacob's dream A ladder (possibly ramp, or staircase), angels ascending and descending
- The imagery God's fellowship with man
- Jesus brings the imagery forward (Jn. 1:51)
- Our access through Him (Jn. 14:6; Rom. 5:1-2)
 - Mediator/Advocate (1 Tim. 2:5; 1 Jn. 2:1)
 - Blessings flow through Him (Eph. 1:1-14; 2:4-7)
 - Our prayers and worship through Him (1 Pet. 2:5; Heb. 13:15)



8. Which of the promises made to his grandfather, then to his father, were now repeated to Jacob when the Lord appeared to him in a dream?

- Land, nation, and seed
- Protection and a return to the land of promise
- Confirmation of Isaac's request in verse 4



- 9. How did Jacob react to the dream?
 - Awoke, startled and afraid
 - "Jehovah is here, and I did not know"
 - Monument and renaming
 - A vow to God
 - o Three requests... presence, provision, and protection
 - Three promises... devotion, dedication, and thankfulness
 - A humbled man
 - What about us? (Rom. 5:8; Eph. 2:4; 1 Tim. 1:15-16)
 - "Nearer My God To Thee"



10. What question does Jacob ask the men encountered at the well and what is their response? (v. 4-8)

- "Do you know Laban, son of Nahor... Is it well with him?"
- "It is well and here is his daughter, Rachel."
- Introductions
- Laban reintroduced



- 11. When asked to name his wages by Laban, what does Jacob propose? (v. 15-20)
 - Descriptions of the daughters
 - "I will serve you seven years for Rachel"
 - "As but a few days"



- 12. What did Laban do when the seven years were complete and what reason does he give? (v. 21-29)
 - Jacob's request
 - "Behold, it was Leah!"
 - "It is not the practice to marry off the younger first, but for seven more years of service..."
 - "He loved Rachel more the Leah."



- 13. What was Leah's expectation/hope, as evidenced by their names, with the birth of each son? (v. 31-35)
 - Rueben "Jehovah has seen my affliction; surely now my husband will love me."
 - Simeon "Because the LORD has heard that I am unloved..."
 - Levi "This time my husband will become attached to me, because I've borne him three sons"
 - Judah "This time I will praise the LORD"



14. List the children borne to each mother, as well as the reasons given for their names. (29:31-30:24)

- Bilhah
 - Dan (God has vindicated)
 - Naphtali (I have prevailed)
- Zilpah
 - Gad (How fortunate)
 - Asher (Happy am I)
- Leah
 - Issachar (wages)
 - o Zebulun (good gift, now he will dwell with me)
 - o Dinah
- Rachel
 - Joseph (God has taken away my reproach)



- 15. During the episode with the mandrakes, what statements by Leah and Rachel are evidence of the pent-up frustrations and attitudes motivating the events of the chapter? (v. 15)
 - Leah "Take my husband"
 - Rachel "Therefore he may lie with you tonight"
 - Leah to Jacob "I have surely hired you with my son's mandrakes."
