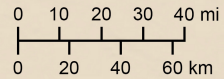

Chapter 3

- “In the course of those many days” (2:23)
- Pasturing Jethro’s flocks near Mt. Horeb
- A bush “burning with fire, yet the bush was not consumed” (v. 2)
- God speaks (v. 4-6)
- Moses’ task and objections (v. 10-11 & 13)
- God’s answers and reassures (v. 12-18)
- “But I know the king of Egypt will not permit you to go...”
