13. How is Joseph described (v. 6)? What effect did this have on Potiphar's wife?

- Handsome in form and appearance
- She looked with desire on Joseph

14. How did he respond to her repeated advances and was the result?

- He refused (v. 8-9)
 - “He has withheld nothing from me, except you”
 - “How then could I do this great evil and sin against God?”
- Day after day, the pursuit continued, yet he ignored her (v. 10)
- When cornered, he fled, leaving his garment behind
- She lied and he was thrown into prison

15. Why did Joseph gain favor and prosper while imprisoned (v. 19-23)?

- “But the Lord was with Joseph and extended kindness to him” (v. 21)
- “... because the LORD was with him; and whatever he did, the LORD made to prosper.” (v. 23)
