GENESIS 47-50

- Joseph and his sons come to Jacob
- "When it was told to Jacob Israel collected his strength"
- "Now your two sons, who were born to you in the land of Egypt before
 I came to you in Egypt, are mine; Ephraim and Manasseh shall be
 mine"
- The blessing
 - "The God before whom Abraham and Isaac walked"
 - "God who has been my shepherd"
 - "The Angel who redeemed"
- Younger blessed above the older... "I know, my son, I know; he also will become a people and he also will be great. However, his younger brother shall be greater than he."

- "Gather together and hear, O sons of Jacob; And listen to Israel your father"
- Rueben
 - Firstborn, might and strength
 - Unstable as water, stripped of preeminence
- Simeon and Levi
 - Violence and anger, senseless brutality
 - Separate and scattered
- Judah
 - Praise, strength, and honor
 - Messianic promise
- Joseph
 - Fruitful and able to endure
 - God (5 times) blessed (5 times)

 - 147 years old; 17 years in Egypt (47:28)
 - Joseph's sorrow
 - Egyptians mourn 70 days
 - Servants and elders from Pharaoh's household
 - Elders from Egypt
 - Chariots and horsemen, a great company
 - Lament noticed by the Canaanites

- Story of Joseph and the similarities to Christ
- Analogy not made in scripture, but worth our consideration
 - Favored Son Matt. 3:17
 - Hated by His brethren Jn. 15:18
 - Dominion foretold Mk. 14:61-62
 - Trusted by the Master Jn. 17:6ff
 - Falsely accused Mk. 14:55-59
 - Stripped of His robe Mk. 15:20
 - Willing to forgive Lk. 23:34
 - Thrown into the pit/earth Matt. 12:40
 - Tomb found empty Lk. 24:12
 - Resurrected a Savior Acts 2:23-24
 - Saw God's purpose in what He endured Jn. 12:27ff; Lk. 22:42
 - God's salvation accomplished through man's wickedness Mk.
 8:27ff
 - Experience fitted Him for future role High Priest, Intercessor,
 compassionate King
