What is the Direction of the churches in the Athens Area? (Rebuilding the Foundation of Fellowship)

• God has clearly shown us the only foundation that will last. (Eph 2:20)

Ephesians 2:20 - having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets,
 Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone,

• This foundation consists of <u>delivered words</u>. (Jn 17:14, 17, 20)

• John 17:14 - "I have given them Your word; and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.

• John 17:17 - "Sanctify them by Your truth."
Your word is truth.

 John 17:20 - "I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word;

Look at how God equipped the church!
 (Eph 4:11-12)

• Ephesians 4:11-12 - And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ,

- When local churches function as they ought then future generations are prepared! *This* begins in the home.
- Bible and church history shows us that God's people often fail in teaching <u>the next</u> <u>generation</u>. (2 Tim 4:3-4)

• 2 Timothy 4:3-4 - For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; 4 and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables.

- I pray you have been personally blessed to have built such a foundation.
- Consistently <u>the first step away</u> from this foundation is a compromised fellowship.
 When a group is moving in a direction it can be hard to resist.

• The desire to put <u>human relationships</u> above God is powerful.

- What <u>kind of leadership</u> exists in local churches?
- There is a great responsibility placed <u>upon</u> <u>elders</u> and <u>upon parents</u>!
- When churches function as they ought then future generations will be prepared!

• God's people often <u>fail in teaching the next</u> <u>generation</u>. (1 Tim 4:1; Judges 2:10)

• 1 Timothy 4:1 - Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons,

• Judges 2:10 - When all that generation had been gathered to their fathers, another generation arose after them who did not know the LORD nor the work which He had done for Israel.

- Consistently <u>the first step away</u> from this foundation is <u>a compromised fellowship</u>.

The desire to put <u>human relationships above</u>
 <u>God</u> is powerful. (Gal 1:10)

• Galatians 1:10 - For do I now persuade men, or God? Or do I seek to please men? For if I still pleased men, I would not be a bondservant of Christ.

- Why have differences on the subject of water baptism historically <u>demanded a separation of</u> <u>fellowship</u>?
- Jesus placed baptism as <u>a foundational</u> doctrine for all Christians. (Eph 4:4-6)

• Ephesians 4:4-5 - There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; 5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism;

• Paul indicated that <u>all Christians</u> were brought into fellowship with Christ and His blood <u>at the point of baptism</u>. (Rom 6:3; Gal 3:26-27)

 Romans 6:3 - Or do you not know that <u>as</u> many of us as were <u>baptized into Christ</u> Jesus were baptized into His death?
