Observations and Lessons from the book of Judges

### Definition

- **a:** Settlement of differences by arbitration or by consent reached by <u>mutual concessions</u>.
- **b**: Something intermediate between or <u>blending</u> qualities of <u>two different things</u>

## Application

The book of Judges, compromise was a blending of man's will and God's will, which involved concessions on both sides

## Danger

- Our will should never be <u>blended with</u> God's will − Instead, our will should be <u>molded to</u> God's will
- Two different things blended together will always dilute purity
- \* It is *unreasonable* for God to make concessions concerning His will (Rom.12:1)
- \* Partial obedience is complete disobedience (1Sam.15)
- \* Compromise corrupted and crippled the Israelite nation (Psa.106:34-46)

# How Did They Compromise?

- Refused to completely drive out foreign nations
  - o They drove out most of them, but not completely
- Refused to destroy false religion (Ex.34:13-16)
  - o They didn't worship the idols, but didn't destroy them
- ⊕ Lived among foreign nations (Ex.23:33)
  - o Not as equals but they did live among them
- Made covenant with foreign nations (Ex.23:32)
  - o Israel was the dominant party but still a covenant

# How Did They Compromise?

## Israel

- Refused to completely drive out foreign nations
- Refused to destroy false religion (Ex.34:13-16)
- Lived among foreign nations (Ex.23:33)
- Made covenant with foreign nations (Ex.23:32)

## Spiritual Israel

- Refuse to completely drive out sin (1Cor.5:6-7)
- Refuse to destroy false religion (2Cor.10:3-5)
- Fellowship with sin and error (2Jn.1:9-11)
- Making a treaty with God's enemies (Jas.4:4)

# Why Did They Compromise?

- \* They Lacked Persistence (Judges 1:19, 27, 34)
  - o They drew back when they had the ability
- - They could keep them in check no temptation
- - O Why waste all this labor that could be used for God?

# Why Did They Compromise?

#### **Israel**

- They Lacked Persistence (Judges 1:19, 27, 34)
- Believed They Had It Under Control (Jud.1:28)
- They Believed That Their Way Was Better (Judges21:25)

## Spiritual Israel

- We Lack Persistence (1Cor.15:57-58)
- Think We Have It Under Control (1Cor.5:6)
- Think That Our Way Is Better (Prov.4:12)

# The Results of Compromise

- Corruption of Standard (Judges 21:25)
  - Everyone did what was right in his own eyes
- \* Corruption of Worship (Judges 2:11-13, 17, 19)
  - o They forsook the Lord and served Baal...
- Corruption of Marriage (Judges 3:6)
  - o They took their daughters to be their wives...
- Corruption of God's People (Judges 19)
  - o Gibeah's crime

# The Results of Compromise Israel Spiritual Israel

- Corruption of Worship (Ju.2:11-13)
- Corruption of Marriage (Ju.3:6)

- Corruption of Standard (Isa.55:8-9)
- Corruption of Worship (Matt.15:9)
- Corruption of Marriage (Matt. 19)
- Corruption of God's People (1Cor.5:6)
