SANCTIFICATION

Sanctify / Sanctified:

- 0037. ἀγιάζω *hagiazō* to make holy, i.e. purify or consecrate

Sanctification:

- 0038. ἁγιασμός *hagiasmos*; from 37; properly, purification, i.e. purity

Holy:

- 0040. ἅγιος *hagios*; from ἅγιος *hagos* sacred (physically, pure, morally blameless or religious, ceremonially, consecrated)

APPLYING THE DEFINITIONS

- Sanctification and Holiness are synonymous
- God's will for us is to be set apart from the world as a reflection of His Son both individually and collectively as a church.

THIS IS THE WILL OF GOD — YOUR SANCTIFICATION (1THESS.4:3)

- Establish your hearts blameless in holiness (1Thess.3:13)
 - To be acceptable to God (Rom.12:1-2)
 - To be a reflection of God (1Pet.1:18-19)
 - To glorify God (2Tim.2:20-22)
 - In every aspect of life (Titus 2:1– 3:2, 8)
