8. God sent a Prophet to Ahab. What did he do to prepare for giving the message and what was his message to Ahab?

- 10. Why did Naboth not want to sell his vineyard to Ahab? How did Jezebel step in on this occasion and what did she do?
- 11. What was the prophecy made by Elijah against Jezebel and Ahab? How did Ahab respond this time to the message? What did his response provide for Ahab?
- 12. What is said about Ahab and how his wife played a part in his reign (I Kings 21:25 26)?
- 13. Who became king of Judah after Asa? What king of king was Jehoshaphat?
