8. Jehoahaz the king of Israel dies, and Jehoash becomes king of Israel?
What kind of king was Jehoash?
9. (II Kings 13:14-24) Elisha becomes sick with the illness of which he was to die. Who comes to visit Elisha and what transpires during the visit?

10. Amaziah of Judah send message to Jehoash of Israel. What is his message and how does Jehoash respond?
11. What resulted in the battle between Judah and Israel?
12. Amaziah was not killed when captured but lived 15 years after the death of Jehoash of Israel. How did Amaziah eventually die?

Uzziah or Azariah (Judah) – 52 Years

Jeroboam II (Israel) – 41 years (evil)

Jeroboam II (Israel 27th year)

Prophets:

Jonah, Zechariah

1. After Jehoash of Israel died, who became king of Israel? What kind of king was Jeroboam II?
2. Although not much is said about Jeroboam II, what are we told that he did for the nation of Israel and its borders? Who had made a prophecy about these events taking place?
3. During the reign of Jeroboam II, Jonah the prophet is told to go prophecy to what nation? What was the spiritual and physical state of the nation of Assyria while Jeroboam was reigning as king over Israel?
4. Let's look at Jonah's commission. Why did Jonah initially refuse to go preach to the people in Nineveh?
5. How did he choose to try and flee from God? What lesson did he learn and what lesson can we learn from his failed efforts?

6. While he was on the ship, how did the men discover that Jonah was the reason for the great storm? How did the sailors deal with Jonah and what did they learn about God through these events?

7. How did God miraculously steer Jonah to the place for his work to be done? Who later uses this miracle as sign for the people of the nation of Israel? What did it signify?

8. What was the basic message Jonah preached to the city of Nineveh? How did the people of the city respond?

9. How did God react to the people of Nineveh's repentance? What characteristics of God do we see Jonah attributing this to?
