While Jeroboam II and Uzziah reign as kings over Israel and Judah, 2 prophets appear on the scene to prophecy to the nation of Israel, the Northern kingdom. We will spend the next couple of classes looking at these prophets and their messages to Israel.

Kings:

Uzziah or Azariah (Judah) – 52 years (good) Jeroboam II (Israel 27th year)

- 6. In 5:27, what does God say would be the punishment that would come upon Israel?
- 7. In chapter 6, What warning is given by God to those who felt at ease in Zion?
- 8. What 3 visons does God show Amos to describe the punishments coming upon Israel? Why does God relent on 2 of them?
- 9. Who tries to stop Amos from prophesying to Israel? What message does God give to him?
