

Servant of the Lord

- The phrase "servant of the Lord" occurs throughout the Bible and refers to people such as Moses, Joshua, David, and Israel (Deut 34:5; Judg 2:8; Ps 18:1; Isa 42:19; cf. 2 Kgs 9:7; Ps 113:1; Luke 1:38).
- God identifies with his servants when he calls them "my servant(s)" (Lev 25:55; Num14:24; Josh 1:7; 1 Chron 17:4; Job 1:8; Isa 20:3; 22:20; Isa 42:1; 52:13; cf. Matt 12:18; Acts 3:13, 26; 4:25, 27, 30).
- Jesus is the Lord's servant par excellence because he served the Father and humanity. How, then, did he show himself a servant?

Service and Sacrifice

- Jesus showed himself a servant through service and sacrifice . . .
 - in his incarnation (Phil 2:6-7; 2 Cor 9:8; cf. "Immanuel, God with Us").
 - in his submission (John 6:38-40; cf. 4:31-34; 5:30).

 - in his self-abasement (John 13:1-17; cf. Luke 22:27).
 - in his crucifixion (Matt 20:25-28; Phil 2:8; cf. vv. 9-11; Isa 52:13-53:12).

Service and Sacrifice

- Jesus showed himself a servant through service and sacrifice . . .

- The service and sacrifice of Christ were effectual because they came from compassion and humility (1 Cor 13:1–3; Luke 11:42).

Becoming a Servant Like Jesus

- How do we become a servant like Jesus?
 - We must humble ourselves just as Jesus humbled himself.
