





DISCUSSION.

1. Josiah. How old was Josiah when he became king? (2 Kgs 22:1) What did he do in the eight year of his reign? (2 Chron 34:3a) In the twelfth year? (vv. 3b--7) In the eighteenth year? (2 Kgs 22:3-7) When he heard the Law and the prophecy of Huldah, what did Josiah do? (22:8-23:27) How did Josiah die? (2 Chron 35:20-25)

DISCUSSION.

2. Jehoahaz and Jehoiakim. Was Jehoahaz a good king? (2 Kgs 23:32) What happened to him? (vv. 33, 34b) What was the relationship of Jehoahaz to Jehoiakim (Eliakim)? (v. 34a) What did Pharaoh Neco and King Nebuchadnezzar do to Jehoiakim? (23:35-24:5)

DISCUSSION.

3. Jehoiachin. What was the relationship of Jehoiachin to Jehoiakim? (2 Kgs 24:6) Why was Egypt not a problem for Jehoiachin? (v. 7) What did King Nebuchadnezzar do the Jehoiachin? (vv. 10-16; cf. 20:17; Jer 22:24-30)

DISCUSSION.

4. Zedekiah. Who made Zedekiah (Mattaniah) king? (2 Kgs 24:17) What was the relationship of Zedekiah to Jehoiachin? (Jer 37:1; cf. 1 Chron 3:15) Summarize Zedekiah's rebellion against Nebuchadnezzar (2 Kgs 24:20; Jer 27:1-22; 38:1-39:10). Explain why Zedekiah was actually rebelling against God when he rebelled against Nebuchadnezzar.

CONNECTION. The Old Testament points forward to Christ and the New Testament. Record any significant OT-NT connections that you observe in 2 Kgs 22-24. In addition, answer the following question and be ready to discuss: How does the prophecy of Jeremiah against Jehoiachin (Coniah) set the stage for the kingship of Christ? (Jer 22:24-30; Hag 2:20-23; Matt 1:1-17)

APPLICATION. Review 2 Kgs 22:11-13 and 23:1-25. Josiah, when he heard the word of God, humbled himself, inquired further of the Lord, and made personal and national changes. How can you and I apply these principles to our own reading of Scripture?
