BOOTS ON THE GROUND









a figure of speech in which a part is made to represent the whole or vice versa

derived from Ancient Greek συνεκδοχή (sunekdokhḗ) 'simultaneous understanding'

Examples go on and on...

- "Friends, Romans, countrymen, lend me your ears" Mark Antony in <u>Julius Caesar</u>, Shakespeare
- ALL HANDS ON DECK
- OFFER ONE'S HAND IN MARRIAGE

Chapter 2 – "saved through the bearing of children..." (v15)

"Childbearing" (KJV) or "the bearing of children" (LSB, NASB)

Strong's Definition: τεκνογονία teknogonía, tek-nog-on-ee'-ah; childbirth (parentage), i.e. (by implication) maternity (the performance of maternal duties):—childbearing.
